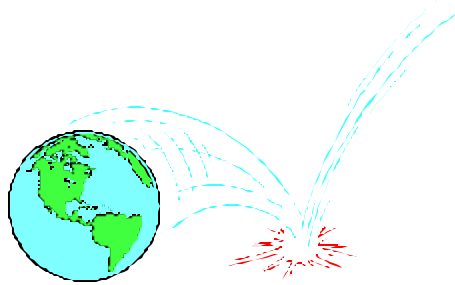


Cora E. & Royal L. Scott Family Endowment

The **Cora E. and Royal L. Scott Family Endowment** was established by Cora E. Scott in 1999. The specific criterion is for a graduate of a South Dakota High School and South Dakota Education major. The scholarship was first awarded in 2001.

Judging Criteria D: This scholarship is weighted to Character, Leadership and Service: Scoring 100 points, the distribution is 25 points Character, 25 points Leadership, 20 points Service, 15 points Financial Need, and 15 points Scholastic Ability.
