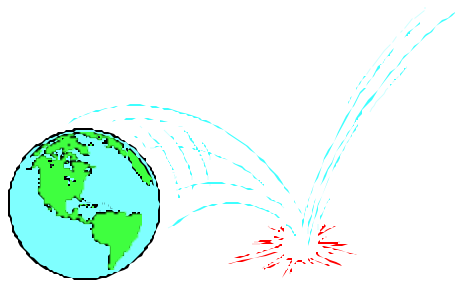


Lauretta M. Roberts Memorial Endowment

The Lauretta M. Roberts Memorial Endowment was established by the Roberts family and the Past State Presidents of the Missouri State Council of ESA International in 1990. The specific criterion is for any major in any state. It was awarded for the first time in 1993.

Judging Criteria A: This scholarship is weighted evenly to Financial Need and Scholastic Ability: Scoring 100 points, the distribution is 10 points for Character, 20 points for Leadership, 10 points for Service, 30 points for Financial Need and 30 points for Scholastic Ability.
